He is wanted in connection with a Feb. 21, 2017, home invasion that has already seen one person put behind bars, according to the Sheriff's Office.

That person is Deborah Hill, 41, of China Grove, North Carolina, who pleaded guilty in November 2017 to charges of false imprisonment, four counts of cruelty to children in the third degree, and four counts of making a false statement, according to court records.

As previously reported, the home invasion occurred following a visit from Hill with her two juvenile children to the home of her father on Feb. 21. Two hours later, 911

Dispatch received a call from the victim's residence in Union County, said Osborn. When authorities arrived,

they found that the home's resident, an elderly man in a state of dementia, had been secured to a chair with duct tape, hooded and taped around the throat, and severely beaten, said Osborn.

The home invasion was an attempt to extort money from the man, said Osborn.

In the course of investigation, it was determined that Hill had been in the area about a month prior to the home invasion and had managed to

secure thousands of dollars from her father's bank account. Hess and Hill were

arrested shortly after the crime

and indicted together in April of 2017, though only Hill has received a disposition in the As part of her plea deal, Hill received a sentence of 20 years to serve five, which means

that she will serve five years in

prison and the remainder of

her sentence on probation,
