Firefighters...continued from Page 1A types of fires we want to go to;

we want to go to something that is savable and we can get everyone out safe along with their house and belongings, but these fires happen." Chief Dyer wanted to

emphasize the work of the volunteers who responded to the scene and devoted time out of their lives to ensure the fires were safely extinguished. Both fires took around

four hours to completely control, with around 20 volunteers going out in the harsh cold during the night to help solve the situation.

"We had volunteers in the upper 20s for each call,

which is great," said Dyer. "We usually don't have that many people respond, and they did a really good job. They take three to four hours of pretty intense labor to make sure these fires get put out."

These volunteers choose to drop whatever they are it at least three feet away, but doing - dinner with families, I would say five just to be relaxing outside of work, etc. – to respond to structure fires no matter the weather or information on how to prevent emergency, and they do it to keep their communities safe.

"With the cold weather, people want to heat their homes, so No. 1, every year they need to make sure their heating units are inspected and

their chimneys are inspected," said Dyer. "If they are using any kind of alternate heating, such as a kerosene heater or heating like that, they need to make sure they keep everything flammable away from it.

"They usually say keep cautious."
