
Additionally, the jury found Heaton guilty of 27 counts of dispensing prescriptions without a legitimate medical purpose to two other patients.

David Gowder was first arrested for prescription fraud in April 2015 in Fannin County. He was arrested again in February 2016 by the Union County Sheriff's Office, as were Mike Gowder and Heaton, in connection with other prescription drug charges

Regarding the outstanding state charges against the three men, which were brought prior to their federal indictments, Enotah Judicial Circuit District Attorney Jeff Langley said previously he would make a decision about moving forward with local charges after the federal sentencing.
