Track and Field Sectionals: Union County sending six to State

BREMEN - Brendan Bowman, Luke Gambrell, Hunter Hartzog, Evelyn McBride, Guage Shumaker and Zoe Sanchez have all punched their tickets to this weekend's State Championships following their respective performances at the Class AA State Sectionals.

Sanchez recorded the fastest times in both the 1600 and 3200M events, clocking in at 5:41 in the 1600 (8.5 seconds ahead of second place) and 12:35 in the 3200 (11.5 seconds ahead of second).

McBride's height of 4-10 in the High Jump was good enough to qualify for state - which will be hosted by Berry College, beginning Thursday.

Hartzog placed second in the 800 with a time of 2:04, just two seconds back of first place. He was also the 1600 runner-up with a time of 4:48 - less than four seconds behind first.

Gambrell was second in the 3200, finishing at 10:42, more than 20 seconds out of first. Shumaker placed fourth with a time of 11:04 in the 3200.

Bowman came in sixth in the 400M event with a time of 51.34, less than 1.4 seconds behind the leader.

Finally, despite not qualifying for the final weekend, Molly Kay West set a school record in the Triple Jump with a distance of 31-feet, 6 inches.


Golf: Lady Panthers qualify for sixth consecutive State Championship match
