8 p.m. that Thursday, when a deputy with the Fannin County Sheriff's Office attempted to pull Hester over for a traffic violation on old U.S. 76 in Morganton, according to Blairsville Assistant Police Chief Michael Baxter.

"A chase ensued in Fannin County coming towards Union County," said Baxter. "The vehicle was traveling at a high rate of speed and refused to stop It was just past sunset

that evening, and when Hester cut the headlights of his '91 Honda Accord, Fannin County authorities decided to call off the chase in the interest of public safety, said Baxter.

"At that time, they did radio Union County to let them know that the vehicle was headed our way," said Baxter. "On Blue Ridge Highway, the Union County Sheriff's Office

observed the vehicle traveling at excessive rates of speed (98 in a 55-mph zone).

"Due to safety reasons, they did not pursue the vehicle, but they notified us to tell us that it was traveling at a high rate of speed into the City of Blairsville."

their brothers in blue, Blairsville Police were able to set up a roadblock with spike strips at the intersection of Blue Ridge Street and old Blue Ridge Highway, said Baxter.

"The vehicle drove around the spike trips that were laid in place by our units," said Baxter. 'It did go up into the Park & Ride area. He went in the wrong way of the Park & Ride, but thankfully, nobody was there.

"The individual went to the end of the Park & Ride and jumped the curb, damaging his

vehicle, and into the intersection of Georgia 515 and US 129, and at that point continued to travel eastbound on 515."

Hester's vehicle was damaged in the pursuit, including his front tires, which dramatically reduced his speed to between 30 and 40 mph as he made his way up 515, said

"The individual was still With enough notice from trying to elude us, and at that point, the decision was made that we would make contact with the vehicle and stop the pursuit,"

Driving alongside Hester, Baxter made a PIT maneuver -Pursuit Intervention Technique - into the damaged vehicle, causing Hester's car to spin to a stop, said Baxter, and the vehicle came to a rest near the main entrance of the United Community Bank on 515.

Another person was in the car with Hester, though that person was allowed to leave the scene at the conclusion of the investigation that Thursday,

'Thank the Lord nobody got hurt, because this individual appeared to be acting recklessly without regard to anybody's safety, any of the motoring public, and he had to be stopped," said Baxter.

Assistant Police Chief Baxter added that he was thankful for the cooperation of other law enforcement agencies that responded to the incident, including the Union County Sheriff's Office, the Fannin County Sheriff's Office and the Georgia State Patrol.

Sheriff's Office has charged Hester with super speeder and driving without headlights. and Baxter said that the Fannin County Sheriff's Office will be pursuing felony charges against
