A. The construction of the Double Gym has been ongoing all winter and we are hopeful that it will be completed by the middle of July. Hopefully the Covid-19 Pandemic will be over by then and we will not have to deal with an empty facility. The double gymnasium will consist of two full size basketball courts that are divided by offices, restrooms, concessions, and a nice community meeting area or birthday celebration area for the kids

Q. When will the Pickleball Courts be open and ready to use?

A. Actually, the Pickleball Courts are practically completed right now. However, because of COVID-19 guidelines and the completion of the exterior part of the double gymnasium, it will be about 30 days before they will be open. There will be eight courts and they are located directly behind the Union County Health Department. The driveway going to the back of the Double Gym must be completed prior to opening the Pickleball Courts to allow safe access for walking and vehicles.

Q. Do you know when the new "Covered Run Out Shoot" at the Union County

Arena will be completed? A. This addition to the Union County Arena is nearly complete. This will provide a huge covered area for not only staging the barrel races, but to offer staging for rodeos, horse shows, and many other events. Unfortunately, the winter rains and storms have drastically slowed down this project, but with just a little more good weather, it will be ready for show season, whenever that will be this year due

to COVID-19. An addition to the concession area and new restrooms was constructed last year at the Arena. These projects have been on the drawing board for several years and we are delighted to have the arena complete.

Q. We heard that a new Dog Park is being built near the Farmers Market. When will it be completed?

A. The Off-Leash Dog Park or the "Paw Park" as it is called, is about 70 percent complete. Most of the fence is already up with just a little more for that to be complete. The shelter for pet owners still needs to be built and all of the benches need to be installed. We still do not have the exact date that it will be complete but hope within the next 60 days.

youth's room or personal effects

Physical or mental changes (memory lapses, poor concentration, lack of coordination, slurred speech, etc.)

Warning signs indicate that there may be a problem that should be looked into-not that there is definitely a problem. If there is suspicion that a youth is abusing substances, it is important to first speak with the youth to get a better understanding of the situation. The next step would be to have the youth screened for substance use by a professional (e.g., school counselor, social worker, psychologist).

If there is no clear evidence of abuse, families should contact their primary health care physician to rule out a physical problem. If formal intervention is necessary, local substance abuse professionals should be contacted.

In addition, it might be helpful to learn more about screening tools, prevention efforts, and treatments.
