His personal records include an 11.29 in the 100M; a 23:20 in the 200M; a 49:85 in the 400M; a 5-8 in the high jump and a 21-6 in the long jump.

"I want to thank my family for all of their support," he added. "I wouldn't be here without my family. I want to thank Beth and Matt Brown for everything they've done over the past few years. I want to thank my mom for making me the person that I am.'
