12U Baseball eliminated in semifinals; State brackets set for 12U softball

Loyd fanned seven Dragons while walking two and hitting one batter. He was also helped out by stellar defensive play as Union County committed only one fielding error and catcher Jace Vinez cut down three potential base stealers.

In Saturday's opening round of tournament play, Hunter Fleming got the nod and picked up the win on the mound in a 17-2 Panther victory over Lumpkin County. Fleming, Loyd and Isaac Cole scored three runs apiece for Union County.

Fletcher and Vinez each tacked on two runs; Totherow, Harkins and Duncan also scored in the Union victory.

Trailing 2-1 to Hall County after one inning in round two on Saturday, the Panthers rattled off six runs in the second to spark a 12-5 victory. Cole would pick up the win for Union County while helping himself out by scoring two runs.
