# Football: Meet the Team another success; season opens Friday vs East Hall

Union County's annual Meet the Team drew a large crowd on the final Friday night without Panther football.

The meet-and-greet brought players, cheerleaders, and coaches out to Mike Colwell Memorial Stadium for pictures, autographs, or just a simple "good luck" wish from Panther fans of all ages.

"We had a really good turnout for Meet the Team," Union County Head Coach Brian Allison said. "The cheerleaders were here and did a wonderful job. We had a lot of young people come out. The quarterback club does a really great job of putting it on every year."

Now Coach Allison turns his attention to Union County's week one opponent, East Hall.

The Vikings are coming off an ugly 70-6 home loss to Flowery Branch. The Falcons took a 57-6 advantage into the half and never looked back.

The 70-6 score, however, means nothing to Coach Allison. He's well aware of East Hall and its 280-pound running back Cambren Harrison, who rushed for 147 yards and a school record 6 touchdowns in East Hall's 62-42 win over the Panthers last September.

They also return the entire offensive line from last season's State Sweet 16 squad.

In the win over Union, the Vikings O-line allowed the running game to churn out 300 yards on 36 attempts - an average

of 8.3 yards-per-carry. "They are really good on the offensive line," Allison said. "They've got (Harrison) back but their strength is their offensive and defensive line.

East Hall will need Harrison and the O-line to pound defenses into submission following the loss of do-everything quarterback Austin Parker.

Parker led all classifications in passing yards with 4,563. He also connected on 50 TD passes to only 3 interceptions all coming in the 59-57 Sweet 16 loss to Westminster.

"They played three different quarterbacks (vs Flowery Branch) and all of them can do some good things," Allison said. "You have to contain them and not let them leave the pocket. They can also throw it a little bit and their receivers are good enough to go get it.'

The last two Union County vs East Hall matchups both ended in shootouts (a 51-46 W in 2016 and a 62-42 L in 2017) and Allison says that is a real possibility this year.

"There is a chance of that happening again," Allison said. "(East Hall does) some things that could give us problems. Like I said, their strength is their front line and we'll need to rise up to the challenge.

"We'll need to have some Parker also ran for 652 success throwing the football and we'll also have to run the football well.

The last victory over the Vikings was a 51-46 home win in 2016 - ending a four-game skid to East Hall that dated back to 2004

Union County is 2-4 vs the Vikings under Coach Allison.

As for East Hall, they are under the direction of first-year coach Scott Patrick. This Friday marks the first

time since 1959 the teams have met as non-region opponents.

Union County and head coach Bill McGraw won that game 12-6 in Rabbittown.
