Crime Information Center.

Clay County Sheriff Bobby Deese also notified the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children and requested an AMBER Alert. The next day, Deese turned to the public via Facebook to ask for anyone's help in locating the missing girl.

The sheriff posted a public timeline of possible sightings and developments in the case, and he and his department worked around the clock to chase down leads and monitor video surveillance systems in the area.

She was reportedly seen at the Dollar General in Hayesville and near Valley River Brewery in Murphy, North Carolina, on Oct. 30; at Downtown Pizza in Murphy on Halloween; and at a residence in Graham County, North Carolina, also on Oct. 31.

None of the sightings turned out to be her, though the Clay County Sheriff's Office did ultimately locate her after surveilling places of interest developed using forensic electronic evidence by the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation, Deese

successful effort that led to the safe recovery of the teen, which Deese said was made possible with help from the Towns County Sheriff's Office Cherokee County, North Carolina, Sheriff's Office, and

North Carolina SBI. Sheriff Deese also lauded the Center for Missing & Exploited Children as an important resource in situations like this one.

"The National Center for Missing & Exploited Children is a private, nonprofit 501(c)(3) corporation whose mission is to help find missing children, reduce child sexual exploitation, and prevent child victimization," per missingkids.org.

"NCMEC works with families, victims, private industry, law enforcement, and the public to assist with preventing child abductions, recovering missing children, and providing services to deter and combat child sexual exploitation."

Continuing, Deese stressed the importance of resources like AMBER Alert, which quickly gets word out to the public whenever a child goes missing.

The acronym AMBER stands for America's Missing: Broadcast Emergency Response, which was created more than two decades ago in honor of 9-year-old Amber Hagerman, "who was kidnaped while riding her bicycle in Arlington, Texas, and then brutally murdered," per amberalert.ojp.gov.

"AMBER Alerts are emergency messages issued when a law enforcement agency determines that a child has been abducted and is in imminent danger. AMBER Alert instantly galvanizes communities to assist in the search for and safe recovery of an abducted child."

Such alerts are broadcast via radio, TV, road signs, cell phones, and other data-enabled






