"Intel led that (these individuals) had just re-upped their methamphetamine supply, bringing back to Union County, when we snatched them up," said Detective Sgt. Miller, speaking on the July 26 arrest.

In a separate incident on Friday, July 22, at a home off Hicks Gap Road near Mulkey Gap, UCSO investigators broke up what they call a "one-pot" methamphetamine lab (picture 2-liter and 20-ounce soda bottles with tubes and household chemicals), according to the sheriff's office.

"Investigation led to a search warrant on this residence for methamphetamine," said Detective Sgt. Miller. "The sheriff's office had made controlled buys out of this residence from Thomas Duckworth and Amber Graham

"Upon doing the search warrant, quantities of methamphetamine were located along with a one-pot meth lab, or a shake-and-bake meth lab, the 07/2 cheap way to make meth.

The process for making 07/2meth is extremely dangerous, noted Detective Sgt. Miller, 07/2" saying that flash fires often occur when using this particular method.

Duckworth was arrested 07/3and charged with distribution of methamphetamine and manu-07/2facturing methamphetamine, and Graham was arrested for 07/28 distribution of methamphetamine. 07/28

"Levi Farist was a subject there that we weren't expecting to be there, but we had 07/2 warrants on him for distribution of methamphetamine, so he was 07/29easy to catch – right place at the right time," said Detective Sgt. Miller.

And in three more separate incidents, the following individuals were arrested, accord-07/28 ing to UCSO investigators:

Brandon Baker, arrested July 27 for possession of a controlled substance, criminal attempt (to distribute), use of communications in committing or facilitating a drug transaction.

07/2Jackson Carpenter, arrested July 28 for two counts distribution of methamphetamine.

Jerry Goodner, arrested July 28 for distribution of methamphetamine, two counts distribution of marijuana.

"If you sell drugs, we're going to get you," said Union County Sheriff Mack Mason. 07/25 "We will not tolerate it in Union County."


